ORDER ON EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

- (1) Defendants shall file and serve by email their response to Plaintiffs' Motion for Expedited Consideration by 9 a.m. on Monday, October 12, 2020;

(2) Plaintiffs' shall file and serve by email any reply by 1 p.m. on Monday, October 12, 2020;

(3) This Court will grant or deny Plaintiffs' Motion for Expedited Consideration by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, October 12, 2020.

If after reviewing those filings and this Court decides to grant Plaintiffs' Motion for Expedited Consideration, the expedited schedule will look as follows:

(1) Defendant shall file and serve by email any response to Plaintiffs' Preliminary Injunction Motion by 2 p.m. on Wednesday, October 14, 2020;

(2) Plaintiffs' shall NOT submit a reply;

(3) Oral Arguments on Plaintiffs' Preliminary Injunction Motion will be set for 9 a.m. on Thursday, October 15, 2020 via teleconference.
